There is a beautiful stained glass memorial window on the north wall of Holy Trinity, by Artist, Alan Sumner; beneath which are these words

“Dedicated to the glory of God, and to the memory of William Hopton Anderson.
The gift of his sister, Isabel Josephine Handfield Anderson. August 11th 1985.”

Inscribed on a brass plaque attached to the wall beneath the window

To whose memory the above window is dedicated
Born 1895 Died 1975

Joined Royal Australian Garrison Artillery, 1911.
Served with A.I.F. in 1st World War
Transferred to Australian Flying Corps 1916
Served with R.A.A.F. in 2nd World War.

Retired 1946 but for many years continued to serve
on Boards, Commissions and committees connected
with the Armed Forces.

A Vestryman of Holy Trinity Church 1961 - 1974 and a life
long parishioner, who found no service to his church, his country
or his neighbour too humble to perform. “
