

20 GEORGE STREET, EAST MELBOURNE

Early Colonial Georgian style house built in the 1880's.

In 1903, the first Australian headquarters of the "Jehovah Witnesses", at 20A George Street, at the rear of no.20.

The Melbourne Age newspaper of 22nd August 1992, published an article with photographs, to advertise the forthcoming Auction. [Page 33]
