He carried through the embarkation of the Brigade to France in November last with conspicuous success. His thorough grasp of Staff duties was responsible for the relief of the 103rd Brigade in the line without a hitch although the 9th Brigade had been only a few days at the front.</p> <p>During the enemy offensives of 22nd January and 31st January, 1917, he carried out his duties in a most efficient manner, while the success of the two raids conducted by the 33rd Battalion was largely due to his forethought and management of the staff work incidental thereto.
